






As a labial letter, meem corresponds to the sound made by the two lips when they come into contact





We should hide the Meem and pronounce it with Ghunnah; and this Ghunnah should be for 2 beats.

The Taween is called nunation and stands for an extra i at the end of the word, which you pronounce but do not write. It practically means that you add a pronounced "n"

Taking into account that Tajweed is based on pronouncing, not writing, the Tanween rules will follow the same principles as Noon Sakinah.


What does "Madd" mean in Tajweed?

At the tajweed rules "madd" is prolonging the voice when pronouncing the letter.

The way of pronouncing the Madd can be prolonged from 2 to 6 beats depending upon its kind.





We call the 3 long vowel marks:
 the letters of prolongation or the letters of "Madd"

Moving forward, whenever encountering the term "The Letters of Madd", it is imperative to know that we refer to one of three distinct letters with specific prerequisites: Alif Sakinah preceded by a letter with Fathah, Yaa Sakinah preceded by a letter with Kasra, or Waw Sakinah preceded by a letter with Dhammah.

THRD: MADD SILAH SUGHRA

- In Arabic, the word Silah means: Connection, and the word Sughra means: Minor.
- It refers here to the third-person masculine singular pronoun, Haa (4), which is attached to the end of a word (meaning "him" or "his"), as in the word:

FRST: DEPENDING ON HAMZA

2. Munfasil

- In Arabic, the word + + Munfasil means: seperated
- This Madd takes place when a word concludes with a Madd letter and is succeeded by a Hamzah, located within the initial letter of the subsequent word.
- Method of pronunciation:
- We shall prolong the duration of the Madd letter by 2 or 4 beats (Haraka)





The reader cannot switch from 2 beats to 4 beats randomly in one reading, but we fix one way or the other, either 2 beats or 4 beats throughout the reading

- In Arabic, the word

 Aridh Li-Ssukoon means:

 temporary Madd for stopping.


The origin of the Shaddah holds the key to unlocking the answer to this question. It comprises two letters; the first is a sakin letter and the second is a letter with a short vowel.



Therefore, from a technical standpoint, uttering shadda following the madd letter signifies sukoon after the madd letter nevertheless, the shadda possesses greater emphasis due to its union of two letters.


What are these seven Alifs?

There are seven Alifs that come at the end of only seven words in the Quran.

These Alifs have on oval shaped Sukoon on top of them "O"

The Rules of the seven Alifs

1) Skip it:


The seven Alifs are not pronounced when completing the recitation of the Quran without stopping on them.

2) Pronounce it:

The seven Alifs are pronounced only when you stop on them, not when you carry on reading.
